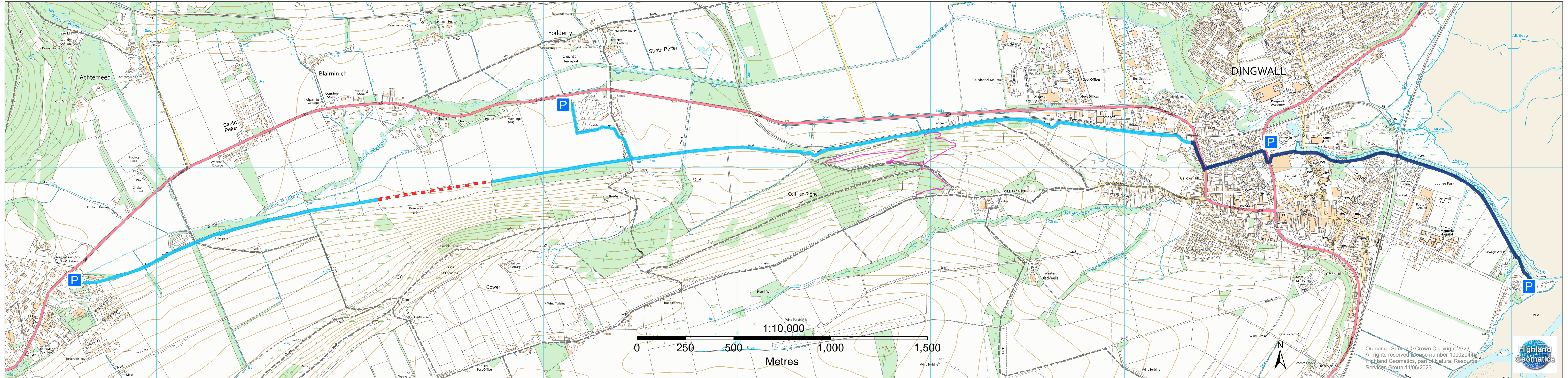
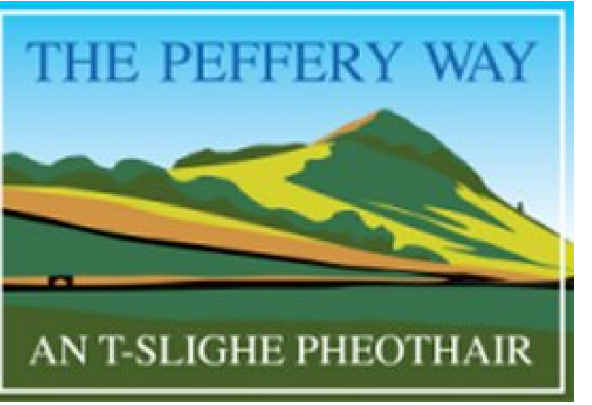


# The Peffery Way
